

Have your say on the Castlemaine, Campbells Creek and Chewton Draft Flood Management Plan

The North Central Catchment Management Authority (CMA) with support from the Mount Alexander Shire Council, various statutory authorities and input from community representatives, has developed a Draft Flood Management Plan for Castlemaine, Campbells Creek and Chewton.

Recent flood events in the three towns highlighted the need to investigate flood behaviour and technical solutions.

The Draft Plan recommends building three new levees in Castlemaine, upgrading three existing levees in Castlemaine and the Campbells Creek township, and minor waterway improvement works in Campbells Creek.

Residents are encouraged to provide feedback on the plan by 13 March 2015. Feedback forms are available in copies of the Draft Plan information brochure, which are available at the Mount Alexander Shire Council, Cnr Lyttleton and Lloyd streets, Castlemaine, VIC, 3450, the Chewton and Campbells Creek post office or the North Central CMA, 628 to 634 Midland Highway Huntly VIC 3551.
