

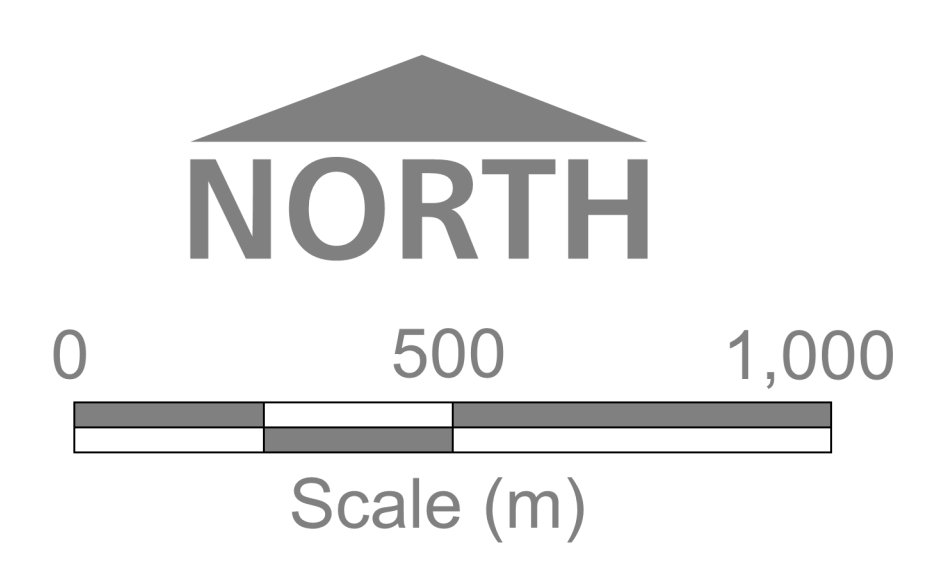

1% AEP FLOOD EXTENTS

- Waterway Flooding (enquiries to NCCMA)
- Significant Urban Overland Flow (enquiries to CoGB)



Annual Exceedence Probability (AEP) is the likelihood of occurrence of a flood of a given size or larger occurring in any one year and is expressed as a percentage (%) risk. The 1% AEP flood extents shown in the above map have a 1% chance of happening in any 1 year.



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
