


Flood Eye User Instructions

Step One

Enter a property address and select from drop down box.




Alternatively:

Enter a street of interest or location and/or utilise the pan (hold left mouse button down and move mouse) and zoom (left hand side of screen) functions to locate a property of interest.




Step Two

Click on the property of interest (or the blue thumbnail if you have entered a complete property address).



Step Three

Select to download Flood Report.



Note: Some locations contain more than one property. Use the blue arrows on the pop up box to scroll left or right to find the property of interest and download the appropriate report.


Step Four

Enter your name (compulsory) and email address (optional)

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
Step Five

North Central Catchment Management Authority (CMA) is the regional floodplain management authority within the North Central region of Victoria. A key role of the North Central CMA is to find out how far floodwaters are likely to extend and how high they are likely to rise. The following information relates to flood inundation that is associated with designated waterways. Designated waterways may be permanent or seasonal, and range in size from a minor to a natural depression across a paddock. To determine if a property is subject to flooding from the local Council drainage system you will need to contact the relevant Council for flood information.

Technical Information

Flood Level Information

This property is located in the Bendigo Creek catchment. Information available at the North Central CMA indicates that a portion or all of the property may be subject to inundation from a flood event that has a 1% chance of occurring in any one year. The following flood information has been sourced from the Bendigo Urban Flood Study 2013. Please note that inundation levels may not be consistent over the whole parcel.
