



Introduction

Examples of works that will arise that require assessment could include:

- Jetties for boating.
- Recreational pathways along stream banks within designated lands.
- Hard lining of the stream bed or piping of the low flows of streams in urban areas.
- Cleaning out dams and relining dams

Assessment Criteria

The assessment should be based on the following criteria:

- Potential to de-stabilise stream bank or bed.
- Potential to alter flood levels.
- Impact on riparian vegetation.
- Impact on in-stream habitat.
- Potential to affect water quality.

Approval for these works should be based on there being no significant impact to each of these criteria.
