The purpose of the North Central Catchment Management Authority (CMA) is to protect and enhance the integrity of our catchments. Our vision is to become a benchmark organisation by working in partnership with our communities to deliver enduring natural resource management outcomes. We are currently seeking an enthusiastic and motivated Project Manager to join our team to work on two high priority water and environment projects.

Located just minutes from Bendigo at our Huntly office, the Project Manager will work within a small team to deliver the Gunbower Forest Ramsar site and Guttrum–Benwell Forests Murray Darling Basin Plan works and measures projects. These projects are aimed to identify efficiencies in the delivery of water to enhance the ecological health of the river red gum floodplains. Responsibilities include the development and management of technical work, provision of water and ecology expertise and engagement of key stakeholders and the community.

The essential criteria to succeed in this role include:

- An appropriate tertiary qualification in science, engineering or natural resource management, together with several years project management experience
- Demonstrated experience in environmental projects, preferably relating to the planning and management of water in waterway and floodplain systems
