The North Central Catchment Management Authority (CMA) works to protect and improve rivers and the natural environment in North Central Victoria. We are seeking an enthusiastic and motivated person to undertake a key community engagement role.

Waterwatch is a national community-based monitoring network which aims to develop the active participation of community groups and individuals in the protection and management of waterways. The position is responsible for:

- overseeing the delivery of the North Central Waterwatch program, ensuring that it meets objectives and budget commitments
- working closely with local landholders, community groups and schools to increase awareness and knowledge about river health and water quality issues.
- creating opportunities to motivate, support and encourage participation in the Waterwatch program
- interpreting and promoting the use of Waterwatch water quality data
- communicating the Waterwatch program's objectives and achievements

Applicants should have experience in water quality monitoring and an understanding of river health principles. Knowledge of, and participation in, environmental education programs would be an advantage.
