This workshop aims to provide information on suitable species for perennial pastures for our region, methods and approaches to move from annual cover cropping to establishment of perennials, approaches to fertility and soil preparation and management of the range of perennials that may be established for resilient and nutritious grazing.

Neil James - pasture specialist

Neil is a local farmer with 33 years at Agriculture Victoria including 25 years in pasture agronomy & livestock extension. Last 10 years working on persistence in perennial pastures and grazing management on farms in our region.

Jade Killoran - agronomist

Jade is the consulting agronomist working with CVRF farmers advising on our farm initiatives, projects and trials. Jade's particular expertise is around establishing and managing cover crops to improve farm soil health and as a basis for establishing resilient pasture systems.

lestyn & Mirinda operate a business collecting native seeds across Victoria supplying the commercial seed sector.
